

Shiloh Cemetery Rules

1. Keep all cars, trucks, and vehicles out of the Cemetery.
2. **Do not** plant or set out: Trees, Shrubbery, or Flowers in the Cemetery.
3. **Do not** place benches, chairs, or stools in the Cemetery.
4. **Do not** build copings (walls) of any kind in the Cemetery.
5. **Do not** place rocks, gravel, glass, bricks or fence on or around the graves or lots.
6. Lots should be marked with identifiable concrete/granite markers, flush with the ground at each grave, within 45 days after making the initial reservation.
7. All stakes will be removed, as they are hazardous.
8. There is a limit of six reserved burial spaces per family plot.
9. The old flowers and standing easels will be removed from the Cemetery.
10. Burials are permitted after the funeral director in charge confirms the reserved burial plot location with the Cemetery Sexton.
11. Any placement of Markers / Monuments must have prior approval by the Cemetery Sexton.
